It is with heavy heart that I announce **EDPMA is cancelling the 2020 EDPMA Solutions Summit** scheduled for May 3-6, 2020, in Nashville, TN. EDPMA **does not** plan to reschedule the event this year.

The health and safety of our attendees is our paramount concern. Upon reflection and consideration of the uncertainty of the status of the pandemic, we decided it was best to cancel versus postpone the event. We did not make this decision lightly. We took into consideration the CDC recommendations, the City of Nashville mandates on non-essential business closures and limitations on gatherings. We also heard from many of our members regarding travel restrictions recently established by their companies.

**We will be preparing refunds for your registration, exhibit table, or Summit sponsorship. We will be in touch with EMRA scholarship sponsors and our year-long corporate partners under separate cover.**

**We would like to offer you the opportunity to avoid any price increase that may apply to the 2021 EDPMA Solutions Summit in Seattle.
